Marian State School will receive**

This funding will be used to

- Ensure every Year 3 and 5 student will either achieve the National Minimum Standard (NMS) for Literacy and Numeracy for their year level **OR** have an evidence-based plan (ILG) to address their specific learning difficulties.
- Support 30 % of Year 3 and Year 5 students to record a performance in the Upper 2 NAPLAN Bands (U2B) for Reading, Writing and Spelling.
- Support 90% of Prep, Year 1 and Year 2 students to achieve Reading benchmark standards as determined by Marian State School Assessment Schedule.

Our strategy will be to

- Consolidate teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching text processing and comprehension as detailed in our whole school Reading Framework.
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching Writing & Spelling as detailed in our whole school Writing Framework.
- Further develop collaborative data inquiry processes to build teachers' ability to interpret data, identify and scale-up effective teaching practices to meet the differentiated learning needs of students.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ a 0.4 Experienced Senior Teacher to co-ordinate professional development, coaching and student support program delivery. \$40,000
- Introduce Read It Again metalinguistic program and remedial support programs for individual students in Prep. \$13,300
- Support teacher aides to consolidate student learning in numeracy & literacy in Years 1-6 Challenge Groups. \$47,000
- Develop and implement a modified Reading Recovery Program to provide intensive support for students identified with Reading difficulties. \$52,000 wages + \$ 9760 resources
- Develop, resource and implement a professional development & coaching program to support teachers in data gathering, collation, analysis and use via Whole Staff & Year Level Meetings.
