This funding will be used to

- Every Yr 3, 5 and 7 student will either achieve the National Minimum Standard for literacy and numeracy for their year level or have an evidence-based plan to address their specific learning difficulties.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN U2B in Year 3 and Year 5 Spelling to 30% and in Year 7 Reading to 15 %.
- Support 90% of Prep, Yr 1 and Yr 2 students achieve Reading benchmark standards as determined by Marian SS Assessment Schedule.

Our strategy will be to

- Establish baseline achievement Reading and Spelling data for each student. The School Leadership Team to monitor and review progress with each teacher in weeks 4 and 9 of each term.
- Provide TA support for P-3 students to achieve half term learning goals in reading and Spelling.
- Establish differentiated 'challenge groups' that will cater for individual Reading & Spelling needs.
- Engage in professional development ie Reading (eg. led by Kay Rankin, How To Teach Reading on-line course) facilitating whole school 'teaching of reading strategies) and Explicit Teaching Practices.
- Use evidence based strategies that maximize student learning outcomes. (References: Archer, Anita & Hughes, Charles – Explicit Instruction: effective and efficient teaching. Guilford, 2011)
