- Close the gap between A-E English semester 1 & 2 achievement in Prep & Year 1 to less than 5%
- 75% of boys in Prep achieve C or better in English in semester 1
- 85% Prep students achieve C or better in English in semester 2

## Our initiatives include

- Ensuring early intervention strategies in Literacy and Numeracy for Prep students are implemented
- Employing 25<sup>th</sup> classroom teacher to reduce early years class sizes
- Providing expert speech language programs to support early years learning and staff professional development
- Providing intensive support for students identifies with reading difficulties and those identified as requiring Individual Curriculum Plans
