- Ensuring 86% Prep students achieve C or above in Mathematics by end of Semester 2.
- Establish High Performing Teams across administration and teaching staff.
- 80% of students on Individual Curriculum Plans achieve C on Semester 2 report cards.

## Our initiatives include


- Ensuring early intervention strategies in literacy and numeracy for Prep students are implemented.
