This funding will be used to

Ensure that:

- 85% of our students achieve the school's Reading and Writing benchmarks as per the school's Assessment Plan.
- 45% of our Year 3 students and 35% of our Year 5 students are operating in the Upper Two Bands in NAPLAN Reading May 2016.
- 100% of staff further develop their own capability in the teaching of Reading.

Our initiatives include


- Ensuring consistent whole school practices around the teaching, learning and assessment of reading within English using student reading data to differentiate to meet learning needs.
- Providing intensive support for students identifies with reading difficulties.
- Building teacher/teacher aide capability in Reading pedagogy and thus ensuring a consistent whole school approach to the teaching and assessment of Writing within English.
 - Supporting teacher aides to consolidate and provide support in Literacy and Numeracy in Years 1-6 challenge groups.
 - Providing teacher aides to support Prep classes in Literacy and Numeracy programs.
- Building staff leadership capability in the assessment of Writing and the proficiencies in Mathematics.
